#### **Today's Starting Five:**

- Missouri S&T opens its 105th season of basketball Tuesday when it plays the first of back-toback games at Billy Key Court, hosting Principia in a 7 p.m. game. The Miners dropped both of their pre-season exhibition games to Division I foes, falling to UMKC on Nov. 5 and 84-77 at Southeast Missouri State on Nov. 7.
- The Miners, who finished last season at 8-19 overall and 4-14 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference, have seven returning players to the roster this winter but lost their top three scorers from last year in B.J. McLaughlin, Zach Ellis and Desmond Buerge -- all of whom averaged in double figures. The top returning scorer is senior Rokas Paulauskas, who scored 9.5 points per contest and led S&T with an average of 7.3 rebounds per game.
- Over the last three seasons, the Miners have averaged 83.7 points per game, the highest three-year scoring average in program history. S&T scored 81.5 points per game last year, which ranked sixth in the GLVC and marked the first time ever that the Miners had averaged at least 80 points a game in three consecutive seasons.
- Missouri S&T also ranked among the GLVC leaders a year ago in turnover margin (+3.07 fewer turnovers than its opponents) and in steals (8.4 per game), while leading the league in offensive rebounds with nearly 14 per game. Rokas Paulauskas led the GLVC on an individual basis in offensive rebounds, pulling down an average of 3.2 per contest.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. Miller enters the 2016-17 season with 153 career assists, which is 66 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 79 steals are 35 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov enters the season in 10th place with 131 career three-point baskets; Kevin Robertson sits in ninth place with 139.

#### **MINER TIDBITS:**

**#2 Randy Holmes:** Transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

**#10 Omer Asku:** Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play.

**#12 Ervin Sarajlic:** Third season in the Miner program...appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...had a season-high four points vs. Central Missouri...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

**#13 Danylo Zuikov:** Enters the season ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 131...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

**#14 Juwan Miller:** Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

**#15 Rokas Paulauskas:** Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T... recorded three double-doubles, including an 16-18 game against UMSL...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

**#20 Telloy Simon:** Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year....played in summer leagues along with current Miner Juwan Miller.

**#21 Quinn Poythress:** Averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to a third place finish in Missouri Class 4.

**#22 Brooks Gerrity:** Played in 11 games a year ago, scoring a career-high eight points against Principia...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

**#23 Dulan Scott:** First season in the S&T program...was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

**#25 Greg Lahm:** Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

**#31 Jalen Myers:** Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago... scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

**#33 Miles Mulkey:** Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

**#44 Jacob Bergman:** One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

### **About the Opponent**

#### Principia:

Principia finished 5-18 last season and was picked to finish next-to-last in the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference this winter. The Panthers recorded a 2-14 mark in the SLIAC last season and enter this season under the direction of new head coach Todd Zimmerman, who was an assistant on the team's staff last winter.

As a player at Principia, Zimmerman established the school's top marks during the NCAA era for career points with 1,556 and assists with 431.

As far as the team he will be coaching goes, the Panthers return their top three scorers from a year ago, headed by Adaku Anumu, who avearged 25.4 points per game to lead the SLIAC and connected 80 times from three-point range. Parker Davidson scored 15.7 points per contest last year and pulled down a team-high 9.7 boards a game, while Justin Ball averaged 12.5 points per contest.

Anumu shot 37.9 percent from three-point range last season, while Davidson, who hit 43 three-pointers, made 36.4 percent of his tries from beyond the arc. However, Principia was guilty of more than 15 turnovers per game a year ago.

#### Series vs. Principia:

The Miners have won all eight previous meetings from the Panthers, including last year's 97-70 win on New Year's Eve in Rolla. Missouri S&T built a 16-point lead by halftime and shot 59.4 percent in the second half to extend the margin, hitting 54.3 percent of their field goal attempts for the game.

The Miners had four players in double figures in last year's matchup, including Quinn Poythress with 13 points and Telloy Simon with 10. The trio of Adaku Anumu, who had 23 points, Justin Ball and Parker Davidson -- all returning players for Principia -- combined for 62 of the team's 70 points a year ago.

S&T is 5-0 against Principia in Rolla.

#### 2016-17 MISSOURI S&T MEN'S BASKETBALL

#### Starting a new year:

Missouri S&T is beginning its 105th season of men's basketball on Tuesday and is opening at home for the fourth time in the last five campaigns. S&T opened last year with an 82-73 loss at Ashland, but defeated Missouri Baptist in the home and season opener two years ago by a count of 102-70.

The Miners have won their last three home openers (Westminster in 2013 and Missouri Baptist in each of the last two seasons) and are 77-27 all-time in home openers; 4-3 under head coach Jim Glash. Missouri S&T has a 61-43 mark in its previous 104 season openers and are beginning a season for the first time ever against Principia.

#### Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

Not only did the Miners have the top mark as a team in the GLVC, they also had the league leader in Rokas Paulauskas who had a GLVC-high 82 rebounds on the offensive end of the floor last season.

#### Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

The Miners had two games of note last year at the foul line. Against Blackburn on Dec. 8, the Miners went 38-of-39 at the line and made 33 straight in the game; the streak would reach 35 before it was snapped two shy of Southern Indiana's NCAA Division II record of 37 set back in the 2002-03 season. S&T also made 40 free throws against Quincy on Jan. 31, the most in a game since the school record of 46 was set in 1955.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.8 percent (1,829 of 2,514) of their tries at the free throw line.

#### **Three-Point shooting:**

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 792 of the 795 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions.
