Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T looks for its first 2-0 start to a season since the 2010-11 season tonight as it hosts Lincoln University at Billy Key Court. The Miners opened the campaign Tuesday with a 104-65 win over Principia, as S&T recorded its highest point total in an opening contest since 1992 when it beat Arkansas Baptist 133-85. Lincoln enters the game at 2-0 and is seeking its second straight 3-0 start to a season.
- The Miners had seven players reach double figures in last night's win, the first time S&T has had seven players score 10 or more points in a game since Dec. 4, 2003 in a 127-42 win over Calvary Bible. It was also the first time seven reached the 10-point mark in a season opener since the 1992 game against Arkansas Baptist. S&T had six in double figures on two occasions last season.
- Over the last three seasons, the Miners have averaged 83.7 points per game, the highest three-year scoring average in program history. S&T scored 81.5 points per game last year, which ranked sixth in the GLVC and marked the first time ever that the Miners had averaged at least 80 points a game in three consecutive seasons.
- Missouri S&T also ranked among the GLVC leaders a year ago in turnover margin (+3.07 fewer turnovers than its opponents) and in steals (8.4 per game), while leading the league in offensive rebounds with nearly 14 per game. Rokas Paulauskas led the GLVC on an individual basis in offensive rebounds, pulling down an average of 3.2 per contest.
- · For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording six assists last night, Miller has 159 career assists, which is 60 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 81 steals are 33 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 131 career three-point baskets; Kevin Robertson sits in ninth place with 139.

MINER TIDBITS:

#2 Randy Holmes: Scored 11 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T... averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#10 Omer Aksu: Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play...had 4 points vs. Principia

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had his first double figure game at S&T vs. Principia with 13 points...appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury... averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Enters the season ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 131...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#14 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#15 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T... had his fourth double-double at S&T vs. Principia...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

#20 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in the season opener vs. Principia...averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year....played in summer leagues along with current Miner Juwan Miller.

#21 Quinn Poythress: Averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to a third place finish in Missouri Class 4.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago, scoring a career-high eight points against Principia...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#23 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#25 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#31 Jalen Myers: Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago... had 13 points vs. Principia in his first Miner appearance...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#33 Miles Mulkey: Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

About the Opponent

Lincoln:

Lincoln, who is coming off a 16-14 season that was the best for the Blue Tigers in 14 years, has three players averaging in double figures two games into the season. That trio is led by Jaylon Smith, who averaged 28.5 points in the two Lincoln wins and led the MIAA with 91 three-point baskets a year ago.

Anthony Virdure, who led LU in scoring last season at 21.5 points a game, averaged 15.5 in the first two this year and Rod Ollison, who made 12 of his 13 field goal attempts to start the season, is averaging 12 points a game. Virdure scored 22 in the win over U-Mary, while Ollison had 16 to back the 24 posted by Smith in Saturday's victory over Minnesota Crookston.

Smith is also the Blue Tigers' top rebounder with 10 per contest, while Richie Lewis has eight assists and six steals to lead LU in those two departments.

The Blue Tigers shot 54 percent in the second half and hit seven three-pointers along the way to beat U-Mary 83-71 in their opener, then completed their weekend sweep with a 76-65 win over Minnesota Crookston on Saturday.

Series vs. Lincoln:

Lincoln has a 39-38 lead in the all-time series that dates back to 1955, but Wednesday's meeting is the first between the teams since Feb. 10, 2010, when the Blue Tigers took the lead in the overall series with a 73-61 victory in Jefferson City.

The Miners, who are 24-11 against Lincoln in Rolla, have won the last two matchups in Rolla and 11 of the last 12, knocked off the Blue Tigers earlier in the 2009-10 season at Billy Key Court by a count of 88-77.

2016-17 MISSOURI S&T MEN'S BASKETBALL

It's early, but...:

Granted, Missouri S&T has just one game under its belt this season -- Tuesday's 104-65 win over Principia -- but after that season opener, the Miners find themselves around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories heading into tonight's contest.

The Miners are ranked third nationally in both scoring and scoring margin, with the 104 points and the 39-point margin in last night's game, while ranking fifth in fewest turnovers (11) and eighth in turnover margin (+10). S&T is also in the top 20 for field goal shooting at 54.3 percent, three-point defense at 21.1 percent and and turnovers forced per game at 21,

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T pulled down 16 offensive boards in Tuesday's win over Principia, including seven by last year's GLVC leader, Rokas Paulauskas. The senior post player had a league-high 82 rebounds on the offensive end of the floor last season.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

The Miners had two games of note last year at the foul line. Against Blackburn on Dec. 8, the Miners went 38-of-39 at the line and made 33 straight in the game; the streak would reach 35 before it was snapped two shy of Southern Indiana's NCAA Division II record of 37 set back in the 2002-03 season. S&T also made 40 free throws against Quincy on Jan. 31, the most in a game since the school record of 46 was set in 1955.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.7 percent (1,846 of 2,538) of their tries at the free throw line. Missouri S&T was 17-of-24 (70.8 percent) in Tuesday's win over Principia.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 793 of the 796 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and made 11 in Tuesday's season opener.
