Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T looks for its first 4-0 start to a season since the 2003-04 season Friday when it faces 4-0 Missouri Southern in the first of two games in the Drury Thanksgiving Classic. The Miners, who have had only 10 previous seasons in which it started with four straight wins, are playing their first regular season game away from Billy Key Court. S&T is facing its former MIAA foe for the first time since early in the 2009-10 season.
- Since the NCAA instituted the three-point line prior to the 1986-87 season, the Miners had never opened a season having made at least 10 treys in each of its first three games of the year -- until now. S&T made 11 three-pointers on opening night against Principia, then knocked down 14 from beyond the arc in the two games that followed.
- Something that has never happened until now: For the first time ever, Missouri S&T has opened a season with three games where it scored at least 90 points in each of them. The last time something happened: The Miners have made at least 10 three-pointers in three straight games for the first time since Nov. 19-30, 2013 and the last time they did it in four straight were the last four games of the 2003-04 season.
- The Miners have a chance this weekend to continue reversing some recent history against teams they once competed against in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association. Since leaving the MIAA in 2005, S&T teams have gone just 4-12 in games against teams from that league. One of the wins came last week in a 91-88 triumph over Lincoln.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording seven assists Wednesday, Miller has 172 career assists, which is 47 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 86 steals are 28 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 131 career three-point baskets; Kevin Robertson sits in ninth place with 139.

MINER TIDBITS:

#2 Randy Holmes: Scored 11 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T... averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#10 Omer Aksu: Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play...had 4 points vs. Principia

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting... appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Enters the season ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 131...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#14 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#15 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T... had his fourth double-double at S&T vs. Principia...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

#20 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season... averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year...played in summer leagues along with current Miner Juwan Miller.

#21 Quinn Poythress: Averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to a third place finish in Missouri Class 4.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a career-high nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#23 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#25 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#31 Jalen Myers: Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#33 Miles Mulkey: Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

About the Opponent

Missouri Southern:

The Lions, who beat Rockhurst 85-74 Tuesday, are off to a 4-0 start as they have also recorded win over St. Cloud State, Minnesota State and William Jewell, the latter of which came after MSSU scored the final 10 points of Saturday's game for a 99-89 win.

While the Miners are seventh in the nation in scoring, the Lions rank 16th at 93.8 per game, headed by CJ Carr with an average of 28.3 points per game. Carr, the nation's second-leading scorer through Tuesday's action, had at least 25 points in the first three MSSU wins and his 47-point outburst in an overtime win over then-No. 17 Minnesota State is the top performance in Division II this season.

Carr, who also leads MSSU in assists (31) and steals (18), is among four double figure scorers for the Lions along with JJ Cratit at 16.8 points a game, Elyjah Clark at 14.5 a contest and LJ Ross, who is scoring 13.5 a game. As a team, the Lions are shooting 43.3 percent from three-point range and have averaged 10.5 treys per game thus far.

Ross is the Lions' top rebounder with seven per game, but MSSU has been outrebounded by five boards per game on the year.

Series vs. Missouri Southern:

Missouri Southern leads the all-time series 25-13 and won the most recent matchup 110-66 on Nov. 20, 2009 in Pittsburg, Kan. Prior to Friday's game, this is the only time the teams have met since Missouri S&T left the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association for the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2005.

The Miners swept the season series from the Lions in S&T's final year in the MIAA, winning 75-68 at home and 74-68 in overtime in Joplin.

It's early, but...:

Granted, Missouri S&T has just three games under its belt this season, but after those games, the Miners find themselves around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories heading into play this weekend.

The Miners are ranked fifth nationally in scoring at 99.3 points per game and are third with 13 three-point baskets per game. The Miners also own a top-10 ranking in three other categories -- scoring margin, where they are third at plus 33.7 per game; rebound margin, where they rank eighth at plus 12.7 a game; and assist-to-turnover ratio, where they sit 10th at 1.65 per game.

Ervin Sarajlic ranks third in three-point shooting percentage at 73.3 percent, while Rokas Paulauskas is seventh in offensive rebounding with five per game and Juwan Miller is 24th in assists with 6.3 per contest.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has pulled down an average of 15.7 offensive boards in the first three games of this season, which ranks 19th in Division II. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 15 boards on the offensive end, is seventh in the nation in that category.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

Last Wednesday in the win over Lincoln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.8 percent (1,872 of 2,573) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 795 of the 798 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and have made 14 in each of their last two wins.

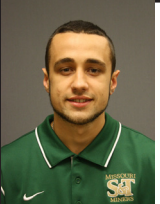

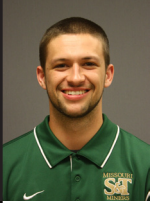
