Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T looks for its first 5-0 start to a season since the 2003-04 season Saturday when it
 faces Emporia State in the last of its two games in the Drury Thanksgiving Classic. The
 Miners, who have had only eight previous seasons in which it started with five straight wins, are
 seeking to also complete a sweep of its three games against teams from its former conference,
 the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association.
- Since the NCAA instituted the three-point line prior to the 1986-87 season, the Miners had never opened a season having made at least 10 treys in each of its first three games of the year -- until now. S&T made 11 three-pointers on opening night against Principia, then knocked down 14 from beyond the arc in the two games that followed and 11 in Friday's win.
- Something that has never happened until now: For the first time ever, Missouri S&T has opened
 a season with four games where it scored at least 90 points in each of them. The last time
 something happened: The Miners have made at least 10 three-pointers in four straight games
 for the first time since the last four games of the 2003-04 season. In that year, the Miners hit 10
 or more treys in their first nine conference games as well.
- The Miners have a chance this weekend to continue reversing some recent history against teams they once competed against in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association. Since leaving the MIAA in 2005, S&T teams have gone just 5-12 in games against teams from that league. The Miners have wins over Lincoln and Missouri Southern this season.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording three assists Friday, Miller has 175 career assists, which is 44 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 86 steals are 28 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 132 career three-point baskets; Kevin Robertson sits in ninth place with 139.

MINER TIDBITS:

#2 Randy Holmes: Has a double-double vs. MSSU...transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#10 Omer Aksu: Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play...had 4 points vs. Principia

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting... appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Currently ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 132...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#14 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#15 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T... had his fourth double-double at S&T vs. Principia...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

#20 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season... averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year....played in summer leagues along with current Miner Juwan Miller.

#21 Quinn Poythress: Has back-to-back 19-point games...averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to a third place finish in Missouri Class 4.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a careerhigh nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#23 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#25 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#31 Jalen Myers: Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#33 Miles Mulkey: Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

About the Opponent

Emporia State:

The Hornets bring a 2-4 record into Saturday's contest after losing 91-74 to Drury Friday. ESU fell behind 20-2 in the first seven minutes of the game, but did close the gap down to four before the Panthers pulled away to send the Hornets to their second straight setback.

Brandon Hall, who leads the Hornets in scoring with an average of 15 points per game, led ESU with 17 points in Friday's loss for a team averaging 84.3 points per game. Brian Morton is averaging 13.3 points a contest, but was held to four points Friday after scoring 24 in a loss to Northwestern Oklahoma State earlier in the week.

Friday's game against Drury Friday before taking on the Miners Saturday afternoon. Emporia State fell behind by 10 points at halftime and by as many as 21 Tuesday and eventually lost 83-79 at Northwestern Oklahoma State, despite getting 24 points from Brian Morton.

Stephaun Limuel and Jay Temaat are both averaging 10.5 per game, giving the Hornets four players in double figures for the year.

Limuel is also Emporia's leader on the boards with 7.2 per game while Morton has a teamhigh 23 assists.

The Hornets are shooting 45.3 percent as a team from the field and have averaged better than 20 points per game at the free throw line in their first six games.

Series vs. Emporia State:

Emporia State holds a 15-8 lead in the all-time series and has won the last six meetings, with the Miners' last win come on Feb. 1, 2003 in Rolla by the score of 76-67.

The Hornets swept a home-and-home series with S&T in the 2012-13 season, winning 66-56 in Rolla and 83-70 in Emporia, the only meetings between the schools since Missouri S&T left the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association for the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2005.

It's early, but...:

Granted, Missouri S&T has just four games under its belt this season, but after those games, the Miners found themselves around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories heading into play this weekend.

Prior to Friday's game, the Miners were ranked fifth nationally in scoring at 99.3 points per game and were third with 13 three-point baskets per game. The Miners also own a top-10 ranking in three other categories -- scoring margin, where they are third at plus 33.7 per game; rebound margin, where they rank eighth at plus 12.7 a game; and assist-to-turnover ratio, where they sit 10th at 1.65 per game.

Ervin Sarajlic ranks third in three-point shooting percentage at 73.3 percent, while Rokas Paulauskas is seventh in offensive rebounding with five per game and Juwan Miller is 24th in assists with 6.3 per contest. The new NCAA statistical rankings will be released Monday.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has pulled down an average of 13.5 offensive boards in the first three games of this season, which ranks 19th in Division II. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 16 boards on the offensive end, is seventh in the nation in that category.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

In the Nov. 16 win over Lincloln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds. Yesterday, the Miners were 25-of-27 at the line and went eight-of-eight in the final 1:08.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 73 percent (1,897 of 2,600) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 796 of the 799 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and have made 10 or more in all four contests this season.
