Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T looks for its first 6-0 start to a year since the 2003-04 season Thursday when it
 opens Great Lakes Valley Conference play against Maryville at Billy Key Court. The Miners won
 in double overtime over Emporia State Saturday to reach 5-0 -- the Miners' first five-game
 winning streak since winning all six of their December contests a year ago -- while the Saints
 enter their GLVC opener at 2-6.
- The Miners have opened the 2016-17 season by scoring at least 90 points in each of their first five games -- or five straight games, for that matter -- for the first time in school history; S&T currently ranks fourth nationally with an average of 97.8 points per game.
- Over the first five games of the season, the Miners have had a different leading scorer in each
 game (in order, Telloy Simon, Jalen Myers, Ervin Sarajlic, Quinn Poythress and Randy Holmes),
 something that has not happened since the 1995-96 season, when the Miners won the MIAA
 title. The five who did it that year were Michael McClain, Jamie Brueggeman, Cam Lindsey,
 Terry Smith and Jeff Kokal and in game six, the leading scorer was Tim Holloway.
- When the Miners knocked off Missouri Southern last Friday after trailing at halftime, it ended a
 27-game streak in which S&T had not won when behind after 20 minutes. The Miners had last
 won a game when trailing at the half on Dec. 3, 2014 at Southeastern Oklahoma State, then
 after coming back for the win over MSSU, S&T did it again the following day after trailing
 Emporia State at the break before winning in double overtime.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording six assists Saturday, Miller has 181 career assists, which is 38 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 88 steals are 26 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 132 career three-point baskets; Kevin Robertson sits in ninth place with 139.

MINER TIDBITS:

#2 Randy Holmes: Has a double-double vs. MSSU, then scored 20 the following day vs. ESU...transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures... prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#10 Omer Aksu: Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play...had 4 points vs. Principia

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting... appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Currently ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 132...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#14 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#15 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T... scored a career-high 19 vs. Emporia State...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

#20 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season... averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year....played in summer leagues along with current Miner Juwan Miller.

#21 Quinn Poythress: Recorded back-to-back 19-point games in November...averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to third in Missouri Class 4.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a careerhigh nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#23 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia... made two free throws with 0.8 seconds left in the 2OT win over Emporia State...was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#25 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#31 Jalen Myers: Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#33 Miles Mulkey: Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

About the Opponent

Maryville:

The Saints are currently 2-6 on the season and dropped a pair of games over the weekend in the Missouri-St. Louis Thanksgiving Classic to Missouri Western and East Central, which snapped a two-game winning streak.

Maryville has two players averaging in double figures on the season in Grant Sims with an average of 15.9 points per game and Forrester Sims (no relation) at 11.3 a contest. Grant Sims, who has played the 12th-most minutes of any player in NCAA Division II, has hit 48.1 percent of his three-point attempts on the year and also leads the Saints with 23 assists while shooting 51.7 percent from the floor.

The Saints have had nine different players make at least two three-point shots this year, but as a team, Maryville is shooting 32.6 percent from beyond the arc.

Karson King is the team's top rebounder with 5.2 per game, while Evan Booker is among the GLVC's top shot blockers with 11. As a team, the Saints are hitting 72.6 percent of their free throw attempts, with four of the five projected starters at 70 percent or better.

Series vs. Maryville:

The Miners hold a 15-7 lead in the all-time series against Maryville, but all seven of the wins by the Saints have come since joining the GLVC prior to the 2009-10 season. A year ago, the teams split two meetings with the home teams coming out victorious, as S&T beat Maryville 83-73 in Rolla on Dec. 3 and the Saints handed the Miners their worst loss of the season in a 98-67 win in St. Louis on Feb. 20.

Since Maryville joined the GLVC, the Saints are 7-5 against the Miners and have won three of those contests at Billy Key Court. Including last year's victory, Missouri S&T has won the last two matchups in Rolla.

It's early, but...:

Granted, Missouri S&T has just five games under its belt this season, but after those games, the Miners found themselves around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories heading into play this weekend.

Heading into Thursday's contest, the Miners are ranked fourth in the nation in scoring with an average of 97.8 points per game, while ranking eighth in scoring margin at plus 21.6 points per game and ninth in rebound margin at plus 10.8 a contest. In addition, the Miners are 17th in Division II with 11.2 three-point baskets per game.

Individually, Ervin Sarajlic ranks second in three-point shooting percentage at 72.2 percent, which is also the top mark in the GLVC.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has pulled down an average of 13.6 offensive boards in the first five games of this season. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 17 boards on the offensive end, is second in the conference in that category behind McKendree's Nolan Gerling.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

In the Nov. 16 win over Lincoln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds. Last Friday, the Miners were 25-of-27 at the line and went eight-of-eight in the final 1:08 to beat Missouri Southern.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.9 percent (1,920 of 2,633) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 797 of the 800 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and have made 10 or more in four of its five contests this season, averaging 11.2 per game.
