Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T, coming off its first loss of the season Saturday, returns to the floor to play a non-conference game Wednesday against Robert Morris-Peoria at Billy Key Court. Missouri-St. Louis snapped S&T's season opening six-game winning streak Saturday and the Miners will look to rebound against an Eagle squad that enters play at 1-6.
- While the Miners' string of consecutive games with 90 or more points ended last Thursday, Missouri S&T did score at least 80 in each of its first six contests -- the longest such streak for the Miners since doing so in nine straight early in the 2013-14 campaign. The Miners currently rank 12th in NCAA Division II in scoring.
- When the Miners knocked off Missouri Southern on Nov. 25 after trailing at halftime, it ended a 27-game streak in which S&T had not won when behind after 20 minutes. The Miners had last won a game when trailing at the half on Dec. 3, 2014 at Southeastern Oklahoma State, then after coming back for the win over MSSU, S&T did it again the following day after trailing Emporia State at the break before winning in double overtime.
- A win Wednesday would give the Miners a 7-1 record to start a season for the first time since the 2003-04 campaign. It would also give Missouri S&T its 16th straight home victory over a non-NCAA Division II school.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording five assists Saturday, Miller has 191 career assists, which is 28 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 89 steals are 25 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 137 career three-point baskets, two in back of Kevin Robertson's 139 for ninth.

MINER TIDBITS:

#3 Randy Holmes: Has a double-double vs. MSSU, then scored 20 the following day vs. ESU...transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#5 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia...made two free throws with 0.8 seconds left in the 2OT win over Emporia State...was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting...appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Currently ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 137...scored 14 in the win over Maryville...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#15 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season...averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a career-high nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#24 Quinn Poythress: Recorded back-to-back 19-point games in November...averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to third in Missouri Class 4.

#25 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#30 Jalen Myers: Transfer to S&T from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#32 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#35 Omer Aksu: Spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play...had 4 points vs. Principia

#42 Miles Mulkey: Newcomer to the Miners who played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

#55 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T...scored a career-high 22 vs. Maryville...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

About the Opponent

Robert Morris-Peoria:

RMU-Peoria brings a 1-6 record into tonight's game and has lost six in a row since winning its season opener over Robert Morris-Springfield. The Eagles have not played since losing 87-82 to Iowa Wesleyan on Nov. 26 in Peoria. Included in the string of six straight setbacks was a 102-64 loss to Missouri-St. Louis -- who beat S&T on Saturday -- back on Nov. 15.

Reggie Davis leads three Eagles that are averaging in double figures with a mark of 12.2 points per game, while Jake Stephens and Jamor Stewart are both averaging 12 per contest. Stephens is the Eagles' top three-point shooter with 11 three-pointers at a clip of 47.8 percent on the season.

Markus Johnson is the top rebounder for the Eagles with 7.4 per game, while Stephens also leads the way in assists with nine.

Series vs. Robert Morris-Peoria:

Wednesday's game between the teams will mark the first-ever meeting between the schools.

The early NCAA numbers:

Through Monday's contests, Missouri S&T finds itself around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories.

With their average of 92.1 points per game, the Miners are ranked 12th in the nation in scoring while ranking 18th in rebounding margin at plus 8.7 per game -- S&T has pulled down more boards than its opponents in six of its seven contests -- and 19th in three-point shooting at 42.9 percent.

The Miners also rank high in three-pointers made per game at 10.7 which is 21st among the Division II schools and are 25th in scoring margin with an average margin of victory of 14.9 points a game.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has pulled down a GLVC-best average of 13.1 offensive boards in the first seven games of this season. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 24 boards on the offensive end, is second in the conference in that category behind McKendree's Nolan Gerling.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

In the Nov. 16 win over Lincoln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds. On Nov. 25, the Miners were 25-of-27 at the line and went eight-of-eight in the final 1:08 to beat Missouri Southern.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.8 percent (1,939 of 2,662) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 799 of the 802 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and have made 10 or more in five of its seven contests this season, averaging 10.7 per game.

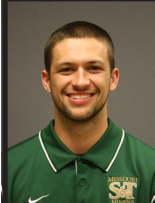

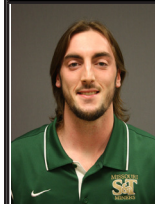
