Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T will seek to close its first semester schedule on a winning note as it faces 12th-ranked Drury in Springfield, Mo., Saturday afternoon. The Miners, 7-1 after a 103-49 win over Robert Morris-Peoria Wednesday, will face a nationally ranked team for the first time this year in the Panthers, who are 7-0 on the season and 2-0 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.
- A win Saturday would give the Miners an 8-1 record to start a season for the first time since the 1996-97 campaign. S&T's current 7-1 start is its best eight-game beginning to a year since 2003-04.
- The Miners' 12-of-12 performance at the free throw line Wednesday marked the first time that an S&T team had not missed a free throw in a game since Feb. 10, 2011, when the Miners went 10-of-10 in a win at Maryville. It was the most made in a game with a miss since Feb. 11, 2004, when the Miners were 16-of-16 at the line in a win at Central Missouri; Wednesday marked just the third time since then in which an S&T team made all of its free throw attempts in a game.
- Missouri S&T enters Saturday's game ranked ninth in NCAA Division II in three-point shooting defense, as it is holding its opponents to 27 percent from beyond the arc. S&T has held five of its eight opponents to five or fewer three-pointers this season, but will be tested by the Panthers as they own the third-best mark from three-point range in the nation at 46.9 percent.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. After recording three assists Wednesday, Miller has 194 career assists, which is 25 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 94 steals are 20 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is currently in 10th place with 138 career three-point baskets; his next will tie Kevin Robertson's mark of 139 for ninth.

MINER TIDBITS:

#3 Randy Holmes: Has a double-double vs. MSSU, then scored 20 the following day vs. ESU...transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#5 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia...made two free throws with 0.8 seconds left in the 2OT win over Emporia State...was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting...appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Currently ranked 10th on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 138...scored 14 in the win over Maryville...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#15 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season...averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a career-high nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#24 Quinn Poythress: Recorded back-to-back 19-point games in November...averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to third in Missouri Class 4.

#25 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#30 Jalen Myers: Currently leads S&T in scoring...transfer from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#32 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#35 Omer Aksu: Had five points and four assists vs. RMU-Peoria...spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play.

#42 Miles Mulkey: Had a season-high seven points vs. RMU-Peoria...played previously at Penn Valley Community College...averaged four points and nearly three rebounds per game for a regional championship team, with 11 steals and 16 blocked shots.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

#55 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T...scored a career-high 22 vs. Maryville...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

About the Opponent

Drury:

Drury, whose most recent game was a 103-68 win over Maryville last Saturday, enters the game at 7-0 overall, 2-0 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference and ranked 12th in the latest NABC/Division II coaches poll. The Panthers, who are also 16th in the D2SIDA media poll, have played all seven of their games on their home floor this year and have won them by an average of nearly 16 points per game.

Four Panthers are averaging in double figures, led by Tevin Foster with an average of 17.4 points per game that ranks fifth in the conference. Foster is shooting 56.1 percent from the field and 46.9 percent from three-point range, while ranking seventh in the GLVC with his 31 assists.

Freshman Isaac Johnson, who has a team-high 21 three-point baskets, is averaging 13.4 points a game and is hitting 46.7 percent of his long range shots, while John Williams and Douglas Moore are scoring 11.7 per game. Williams and Moore are both shooting better than 60 percent from the field for a team that ranks sixth in NCAA Division II in field goal percentage at 53.7 percent.

Moore is also the Panthers' top rebounder with 5.3 per game.

Series vs. Drury:

The Panthers lead the all-time series with Missouri S&T 77-33 after the teams split a pair of games a year ago. S&T snapped a 21-game losing streak to Drury with a 74-56 win in Rolla, before the Panthers beat S&T 95-76 in the season finale in Springfield.

Drury, who owns a 21-1 record against the Miners in GLVC play since the two schools joined the league together prior to the 2005-06 season, has handed the Miners 16 straight losses in their Springfield meetings. S&T's last win over Drury on its home court came on Feb. 22, 1977, when the Miners won 74-69; the teams have played in Springfield annually since 2006 after playing just five times there between 1977 and 2006.

The early NCAA numbers:

Through Wednesday's contests, Missouri S&T finds itself around the top of NCAA Division II in a few statistical categories.

With their average of 93.5 points per game, the Miners are ranked 10th in the nation in scoring while ranking sixth in rebounding margin at plus 11.4 per game -- S&T has pulled down more boards than its opponents in seven of its eight contests -- and ninth in three-point shooting defense at 27 percent.

The Miners also rank high in three-pointers made per game at 11 which is 14th among the Division II schools and are seventh in scoring margin with an average margin of victory of 19.8 points a game. That margin of victory also includes S&T's only loss of the season by 17 points and wins of one, three and six points along the way.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has pulled down a GLVC-best average of 13.4 offensive boards in the first seven games of this season. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 26 boards on the offensive end, is second in the conference in that category behind McKendree's Nolan Gerling.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

In the Nov. 16 win over Lincoln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds. On Nov. 25, the Miners were 25-of-27 at the line and went eight-of-eight in the final 1:08 to beat Missouri Southern.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 73 percent (1,951 of 2,674) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 800 of the 803 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T hit at least 10 three-pointers in a game on eight occasions and have made 10 or more in six of its eight contests this season, averaging 11 per game which ranks 14th in NCAA Division II.

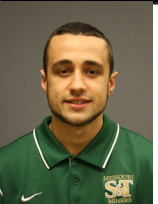

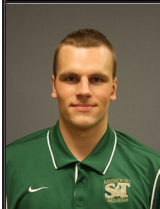
