Today's Starting Five:

- Missouri S&T hits the road for a pair of Great Lakes Valley Conference contests this week in the state of Indiana, beginning with Thursday's game at Indianapolis. The Miners are looking to halt a four-game losing streak as they come in at 7-5 overall and 1-4 in the GLVC, while UIndy has won two straight and is 5-7 overall, 2-2 in GLVC play.
- Missouri S&T enters Thursday's game ranked fourth in NCAA Division II in three-point shooting defense, as it is holding its foes to 28.8 percent from beyond the arc. This is after S&T held UW-Parkside -- the top three-point shooting team in Division II -- to 26.9 percent on Saturday. Missouri-St. Louis and Drury and the only teams to shoot better than 40 percent from outside.
- The Miners come into Thursday's game -- and road trip -- looking to break a run of struggles against teams from the GLVC East Division. Since joining the league in 2005, the Miners have won just two of 36 games over teams from that division, with the wins coming in 2012 at Southern Indiana and in 2015 at Saint Joseph's.
- The Miners' 12-of-12 performance at the free throw line in the Dec. 7 win over Robert Morris-Peoria marked the first time that an S&T team had not missed a free throw in a game since Feb. 10, 2011, when the Miners went 10-of-10 in a win at Maryville. It was the most made in a game with a miss since Feb. 11, 2004, when the Miners were 16-of-16 at the line in a win at Central Missouri; the Dec. 7 contest marked just the third time since then in which an S&T team made all of its free throw attempts in a game.
- For the last three years, the Miners have finished the season with a player that has accumulated 100 assists (last year, it was Juwan Miller with 103) after not having a player reach that mark for a decade. Miller currently has 208 career assists, which is 11 in back of Stan Shuemaker and DeAndre Johnson for 10th all-time at S&T, while his 100 steals are 14 behind Zach Ellis for 10th. Meanwhile, Danylo Zuikov is tied with Chris Dawson for eighth place with 144 career three-point baskets; next on the list is Duane Huddleston, who hit 171 in his Miner career.

MINER TIDBITS:

#2 Jonathen Harley: Became a part of the Miners' active roster for the second semester...averaged 12.2 points and 5.6 rebounds per game last season at West Valley College in California.

#3 Randy Holmes: Has a double-double vs. MSSU, then scored 20 the following day vs. ESU...transfer from Bethune-Cookman who is in his first season at S&T...averaged 6.2 points and 3.9 rebounds per game a year ago for the Wildcats, with six games in double figures...prior to going to BCC, played two seasons at Mineral Area College and averaged over 14 points per game as a sophomore for a team that won the Region XVI championship.

#5 Dulan Scott: Scored 16 points in his S&T debut vs. Principia...made two free throws with 0.8 seconds left in the 2OT win over Emporia State...was a third-team All-Chicago area player last season after averaging 16 points and six rebounds per game.

#12 Ervin Sarajlic: Third season in the Miner program...had a career-high 21 points vs. Calvary on 7-of-8 three-point shooting...appeared in five games last season before suffering a season-ending injury...averaged 4.3 points and 1.4 rebounds in his freshman year before missing the final seven games due to an injury.

#13 Danylo Zuikov: Currently ranked eighth on S&T's career list for three-pointers made with 144...scored 14 in the win over Maryville...averaged 6.4 points a year ago and led the Miners with 39 three-pointers...scored a season-high 18 points vs. SJC...led the GLVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.16-to-1 two seasons ago and finished third in the GLVC with 101 assists, which included an S&T single-game record 13 vs. McKendree.

#15 Telloy Simon: Was one of six Miners to record a 20-point game a year ago...scored 20 in each of the first two games this season...averaged eight points and three rebounds per game and was one of the team's top free throw shooters at 88.2 percent...hit 32 three-point shots during the year.

#22 Brooks Gerrity: Played in 11 games a year ago...had a career-high nine points vs. Calvary in his first start...had five assists and two steals while shooting 43 percent from the floor...averaged 16.2 points and connected on 36.4 percent of his three-point attempts as a high school senior...redshirted in the 2014-15 campaign.

#24 Quinn Poythress: Recorded back-to-back 19-point games in November...averaged 6.1 points and two rebounds per game in his

freshman season at S&T...posted a career-high 21 against Blackburn in his first career start...was second in the GLVC in three-point shooting at 48.3 percent...scored 20.5 points as a high school senior, helping lead Notre Dame Regional to third in Missouri Class 4.

#25 Juwan Miller: Led the Miners with 103 assists last season, which ranked eighth in the GLVC and was third in the league with 46 steals...averaged 7.7 points and 2.9 rebounds per game a year ago after averaging 9.5 points, three rebounds and 4.5 assists per game in the first 11 contests before suffering a season-ending injury in 2014-15.

#30 Jalen Myers: Currently leads S&T in scoring...transfer from South Suburban College, where he earned second-team all-Region IV honors a year ago...had 26 points vs. Lincoln with six three-pointers...scored 12.7 points and pulled down 2.5 rebounds a game while knocking down 41.7 percent of his three-point attempts...3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio was the 14th-best at the JUCO level.

#32 Greg Lahm: Averaged 14.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game during his senior year at Lindbergh High School...averaged 17 points and shot 64 percent during his junior year.

#35 Omer Aksu: Had five points and four assists vs. RMU-Peoria...spent last season at the University of Texas-San Antonio, but did not play.

#44 Jacob Bergman: One of two true freshmen on the Miner roster this season...averaged a double-double at Smith-Cotton High School with 12.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game...also shot 53 percent from the field as a senior.

#55 Rokas Paulauskas: Led the GLVC in offensive rebounds with 82 and led the team on the boards 19 times in his first season at S&T...scored a career-high 22 vs. Maryville...came to S&T from Frank Phillips College, where he averaged 9.3 points and 6.3 rebounds a game two years ago...averaged a double-double at Hamilton Heights Academy in Chattanooga as a high school senior.

About the Opponent

Indianapolis:

The Greyhounds -- who have played in the NCAA Division II Tournament in each of the last six years -- got off to a slow start this season, but have won their first two games out of the holiday break to bring marks of 5-7 overall and 2-2 in the GLVC into Thursday's contest.

UIndy picked up road wins at Missouri-St. Louis and Maryville last week largely due to its play on the defensive end of the floor, as it held UMSL to 31.5 percent shooting and then held Maryville to 35.5 percent from the field. Opposing teams have shot 47 percent against UIndy this season, an average that was at 49.6 percent prior to the two wins.

Jesse Kempson, who recorded a double-double in Saturday's win at Maryville, leads the Greyhounds with averages of 15.3 points and 7.1 rebounds per game and is also fourth in the GLVC with 21 blocked shots. The Greyhounds are also getting 12.5 points a game from Eric Davidson -- who leads UIndy with 24 three-point baskets -- and 10.8 a contest from D.J. Davis.

Jimmy King has a team-high 41 assists for UIndy, while Ajay Lawson's 18 steals rank seventh in the conference.

Series vs. Indianapolis:

The Greyhounds hold an 8-2 advantage in the all-time series between the teams -- all of which have been played since S&T joined the GLVC prior to the 2005-06 season -- and have never lost to the Miners in Nicoson Hall. UIndy is 5-0 against S&T on its home floor and has won those five games by an average of 27 points.

Two seasons ago, the Greyhounds handed the Miners a 98-74 loss in the last meeting in Indianapolis. UIndy won last year's matchup in Rolla 98-82 behind 16 points from Jimmy King and 14 from Alex Etherington.

Projecting it out...

With Missouri S&T's season essentially at the midpoint this week -- 13 regular season games remain on the schedule -- a number of Miners are on pace to reach some particular marks for a single year at S&T.

Juwan Miller is on pace to finish with 114 assists, which would be the eighth-best mark in a season all-time. Meanwhile, at his current rate, Jalen Myers will finish the year with 68 three-point baskets; the 10th place mark for a season is 72. Even if doesn't reach the 10th spot, Myers is on pace to record the most three-pointers in a season by a Miner since Jermaine Burks made 75 in the 2004-05 campaign.

No Miner has finished a season shooting 60 percent or better from the field (with three field goals made per game) since Brian Westre in 2003-04, but Dulan Scott is on pace to end that drought as he is currently at 63.3 percent on the year. In addition, the Miners have had at least one player shoot 40 or better from three-point range in each of the last three years (with one made per game) and currently have three players (Ervin Sarajlic, Tello Simon and Myers) all over that 40 percent threshold.

Hitting the offensive glass:

The Miners finished last season as the top-ranked offensive rebounding team in the GLVC, pulling down just under 14 per game. That mark ranked 14th in NCAA Division II in that category.

S&T has an average of 13 offensive rebounds in the first 12 games of this season, which leads the GLVC heading into Thursday's contest. Rokas Paulauskas, who already has 35 boards on the offensive end, is fourth in the GLVC in that category.

Miners at charity stripe:

Missouri S&T finished last season as one of the top free throw shooting teams in the GLVC, ending up sixth with a mark of 75.1 percent. The Miners had eight regulars all connect on at least 70 percent of their attempts and had four at better than 80 percent.

In the Nov. 16 win over Lincoln, S&T went 19-of-23 at the free throw line and made all seven of its attempts in the final five minutes of play, including six in the last 28 seconds. On Nov. 25, the Miners were 25-of-27 at the line and went eight-of-eight in the final 1:08 to beat Missouri Southern. S&T also had a perfect game at the charity stripe in its Dec. 7 win over Robert Morris-Peoria, as it made all 12 of its tries that night.

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Miner teams have made 72.9 percent (1,995 of 2,738) of their tries at the free throw line.

Three-Point shooting:

The Miners have made at least one three-point basket in 804 of the 806 games they have played since the three-point shot went into effect at the start of the 1986-87 season. At one point in the stretch, S&T had made at least one three-pointer in 597 consecutive games.

Missouri S&T hit 212 three-pointers last season, the 10th time in the 30 years in which the three-point shot has been part of college basketball in which the Miners have made at least 200 in a season. S&T, with 122 treys on the year, has hit at least 10 three-pointers in nine of its 12 contests this season, averaging 10.2 per game -- a mark which ranks 26th in NCAA Division II.
