The Game:

The Missouri S&T Lady Miners look to snap a two-game losing streak as it begins Great Lakes Valley Conference play hosting the Illinois Springfield Prairie Stars on Saturday afternoon at Billy Key Court.

The Lady Miners are averaging 74.2 points per game which is fifth best in the GLVC but have been held to just 61 points combined in the last two games after losses to Union (Tenn.) and Arkansas-Fort Smith this past weekend in Springfield, Mo.

Saturday's contest marks the 12th meeting all-time between Missouri S&T and Illinois Springfield with the Lady Miners having won 10 of the first 11 contests. S&T has won seven straight in the series including a 59-49 victory in Rolla this past February. The Lady Miners are 6-0 all-time against the Prairie Stars in Rolla.

Looking Back:

The Lady Miners dropped an exhibition contest at Indiana State 84-51 on Tuesday evening in Terre Haute. S&T trailed 20-16 with 1:28 left in the opening quarter but the Sycamores outscored the Lady Miners 31-4 over the next 11:14 to pull away for good.

Maddie Raley and Joe'l Bland led the way for S&T scoring 11 points apiece while Janie Arand and Michelle Borgen had eight points each. Borgen also pulled down a team-high seven rebounds.

Scouting the Competition:

Illinois Springfield improved to 5-1 with a 106-27 win over Robert Morris-Springfield on Wednesday evening. The Prairie Stars held the Eagles to just 12 total points over the final three quarters. UIS is off to its best start in nearly 20 years. Its 1998-99 team started the season 7-1 and went on to finish 20-4 that year. The Prairie Stars lead the GLVC in scoring (85.5 ppg), field goal percentage defense (.324), rebounding (48.5 rbg) and blocked shots with 8.3 per contest.

The Prairie Stars have four players averaging double figures in scoring led by Shelbi Patterson who is averaging 13.8 points per game. Destiny Ramsey is dropping in 13.2 points per contest, Jasmine Sangster is contributing 11.3 ppg off the bench and Katelyn Rosner is scoring 10 points per game. Ramsey leads the team with 8.5 rebounds per game and is one of the leaders nationally in blocked shots with 16.

Painting it Green:

A big key to the Lady Miners success to begin the season this year has been their ability to score in the paint as they've scored at 40 least points in three of their six games this season. S&T has outscored its opponents in the paint 216-180 and is averaging 36 points per game in the painted area. Michelle Borgen has done a majority of her damage around the basket shooting 47.1 percent from the field.

The Coaches



Alan Eads, the school's all-time winningest coach, has guided the Lady Miners to a 197-218 record in his 16th season at the helm. He became the school's winningest coach on Jan 29, 2011 with a 65-63 overtime win against Maryville at home.

Last season he guided S&T to a 10-16 mark, 5-13 in the GLVC. He's guided the Lady Miners to the GLVC Tournament nine times including the first nine seasons as a member of the conference.

In his time at S&T he's guided the Lady Miners to NCAA appearances in 2008 and 2011 and were co-champs of the GLVC's West Division in 2010-11.

Mark Kost is in his third season as the head coach at Illinois Springfield. Last year he guided the Prairie Stars to a 9-17 record, 3-15 in the GLVC. Kost guided Syerra Cunningham and Destiny Ramsey to Third-Team All-GLVC honors. In his first season at the helm, the Prairie Stars went 8-18. Kost coached Third-Team All-GLVC selection Shelbi Patterson as well as the conference's second-leading rebounder in Cunningham. Prior to his time in Springfield, he spent one season as an assistant at Charleston Southern and the year before that he was an assistant at Morehead State. Kost also spent 10 seasons on the women's staff at Coastal Carolina where he coached former Lady Miner assistant Kira Carter.

Cleaning the Glass

The Lady Miners have done a solid job on the glass this season averaging 39.2 rebounds per game which ranks seventh in the GLVC while their rebounding margin of +5.7 is fourth in the conference. Kim Runge leads the way averaging 9.2 rebounds per game and ranks third in the conference in rebounds per contest. Michelle Borgen is averaging 4.7 rebounds per game and Ashley Harvey is averaging 4.0 per contest.

Coaching Stability

Alan Eads is the third-longest tenured head coach in the GLVC. Eads, who is in his 16th season at Missouri S&T in 2017-18, trails William Jewell's Jill Cress (22nd season) and Southern Indiana's Rick Stein (18th season). In terms of time spent at GLVC schools he's the second longest tenured behind Stein.

Three Ball Streak

Since the beginning of the 2003-04 campaign the Lady Miners have made at least one three in 383 of their last 388 games. S&T is currently the top three-point shooting team in the GLVC and there 6.7 made three's per game which is tied for ninth in the conference.

The Lady Miners are off to a good start this season shooting the three ball connecting on 41.2 percent tops in the GLVC. They made a season-high 11 three's in the win against Missouri Valley on Nov. 18.

Maddie Raley leads the team with 15 three's made while Janie Arand has knocked down 13, Marta Durk has made five and Jordan Kabetske has knocked down three.

Quest for 1,000

Janie Arand is looking to become just the 14th player in school history to top the 1,000 point mark for their career. She has currently scored 817 points and needs to average 9.2 points per game to reach that mark. Arand would be the first player to join the 1,000 point club since Hailee Parks accomplished that feat back in the 2012-13 season at Rollins.

Defending the Home Court

Over the past 12-plus seasons the Lady Miners have defended their home court very well going 111-74 (.600) during that span. Their best season at the Bullman came during the 2007-08 campaign when they went 11-1. They've had five seasons where they've won 10 or more games. The Lady Miners had their first winning season at home since 2012-13 last season when they went 7-6. S&T has won six of its last seven games at home dating back to last season.

Up Next

The Lady Miners head to St. Louis next Thursday to take on the Maryville Saints in a 5:30 p.m. contest from Moloney Arena. Following that game, S&T won't play again until Dec. 19 when it travels to Joplin to take on Missouri Southern at 5:30 p.m.

#1 Michelle Borgen: First season in the Lady Miner program...averaged nearly 26 points and 11 rebounds per game to help lead Moraine Valley to a 17-19 record...averaging 14.6 points and five rebounds per game this season...scored 24 points against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11. ranked 14th in the GLVC in scoring

#3 Marta Durk: Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program...she scored 1,252 points, grabbed 321 rebounds and dished out 176 assists during her final three years at O'Fallon Township...she finished her prep career averaging 14.9 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game...she's averaging 5.2 points and 1.8 rebounds per game...made a pair of three's against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11.

#5 Karleigh Faust: First season with the Lady Miner program...played in 26 games last season averaging 4.2 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game for Grandview High School in Hillsboro, Mo...helped lead the team to a 22-4 record.

#11 Bria Pierce: Started 22 games in 2015-16 leading the team in scoring with 11.8 points per game and had 16 double digit scoring performances...scored a career-high 23 points at Maryville on Feb. 20, 2016...also averaged 5.1 rebounds per game.

#14 Jordan Kabetske: Second year with the Lady Miner program...scored a career-high 11 points in the season opening win over LeMoyne-Owen on Nov. 10 and then matched that with 11 against Purdue Northwest the following night...currently averaging 7.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game.

#22 Kim Runge: In her fourth year with the Lady Miners averaging 3.4 points and 3.9 rebounds in her career...she grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds, 10 on the defensive end, and added six points in the win over Purdue Northwest on Saturday...ranks third in the GLVC in rebounding with 9.2 per game.

#23 Katie Moreno-Bonnett: Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program after playing the last two seasons at Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City...started 24 games as a sophomore averaging 7.1 points and 5.5 rebounds per game...reached double figures in scoring seven times and had a career-high with 15 against Wentworth Military Academy.

#24 Janie Arand: Has scored 20 or more points five times in her career with four of those coming the past two seasons. She scored a career-high 31 points on 11-of-18 shooting in the season-opening win against LeMoyne-Owen...led the team in scoring last year averaging 10.8 points per game...she needs 183 points to join the 1,000 point club at Missouri S&T...currently ranked fifth in the GLVC in scoring and sixth in three-point field goal percentage.

#30 Joe'l Bland: Matched her season-high with 10 points at Lincoln (Nov. 14) and has scored in double figures 15 times in her career...scored a career-high 22 points against William Jewell in her freshman season on Feb. 21, 2015...for her career she's averaging 5.8 points, 2.7 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 1.1 assists per game and has connected on 46.6 percent of her field goal attempts.

#32 Ashley Harvey: In her first season with the Lady Miner program...recorded season-highs in points with nine and rebounds with seven in the win at Lincoln on Nov. 14...began her collegiate career at Penn Valley averaging 10 points and eight rebounds before suffering a season ending injury...was an all-conference performer at Raytown High School in Raytown, Mo...currently averaging 5.2 points and 4.0 rebounds per game.

#33 Kristin Steins: Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program...was a three-sport athlete at Parkway South where she averaged 13.5 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.5 steals per game...she was a three-time all-conference and all-district selection and was the Player of the Year in the Suburban West Conference last year...she's also a member of the Lady Miner soccer team...scored her first two points of the season against Union on Nov. 24...followed that up with two points against Arkansas-Fort Smith on Nov. 25.

#34 Maddie Raley: Second season with the Lady Miner program...she appeared in all 26 games...she averaged 6.1 points and 1.7 rebounds per game...she matched her career-high scoring 20 points against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11... she made a career-high six three's at Bellarmine last season...she currently leads the team with 15 three-pointers made...Raley ranks fourth in the GLVC in three-point field goals made per game with 2.5, eighth in 3-point field goal percentage and 10th in scoring.
