## The Game:

The Missouri S&T Lady Miners look to snap a five-game losing streak as it begins a stretch where it will play four of its next six games at Billy Key Court.

The Lady Miners are averaging 68.9 points per game which is eighth in the GLVC but have been held to just 59.4 points during their five-game losing streak. They've allowed nearly 81 points per game during this stretch.

Saturday's game will be the ninth meeting all-time between the Lady Miners and Blue Jays with all of the meetings coming within the last 10 years. S&T held a 13-point lead at halftime in last year's contest but had to hold off a late charge by the Blue Jays to secure the victory. Raetchel Gray and Elsie Greenwood led the way for the Lady Miners with 16 and 13 points respectively. Mirrakohl Johnson led Westminster with 19 points while Andrea Zalis added 11 points and 11 rebounds.

## Looking Back:

S&T couldn't overcome a fast start by Missouri Southern in a 77-61 loss in its final game before the Christmas break. The Lions hit their first 11 shots of the game including five three-pointers to build a 33-18 lead at the end of the first quarter.

Maddie Raley led the Lady Miners with 19 points while Janie Arand dropped in 11 and Jordan Kabetske finished with nine.

## Scouting the Competition:

Westminster has dropped two of its last three games and enters Saturday's contest with a mark of 5-4. The Blue Jays played an exhibition game at Colorado last Thursday falling to the Buffaloes 106-47. Payton Beeler led the Jays with 19 points off the bench.

Westminster has two players averaging double figures in scoring led by Kendahl Adams who is averaging 16.8 points per game while Johnson is adding 15.1 points per contest. Grace Archambault is dropping in 8.2 ppg. Johnson leads the team in rebounding with 9.0 rebounds per contest and Adams leads the team in assists with 33.

## Painting it Green:

A big key to the Lady Miners success to begin the season this year has been their ability to score in the paint as they've scored at 40 least points four times this season. S&T has outscored its opponents in the paint 320-279 and is averaging 35.6 points per game in the painted area.

### The Coaches



Alan Eads, the school's all-time winningest coach, has guided the Lady Miners to a 197-221 record in his 16th season at the helm. He became the school's winningest coach on Jan 29, 2011 with a 65-63 overtime win against Maryville at home.

Last season he guided S&T to a 10-16 mark, 5-13 in the GLVC. He's guided the Lady Miners to the GLVC Tournament nine times including the first nine seasons as a member of the conference.

In his time at S&T he's guided the Lady Miners to NCAA appearances in 2008 and 2011 and were co-champs of the GLVC's West Division in 2010-11.

James Arnold is in his first season as the head coach at Westminster. He comes to the Blue Jays with head coaching experience at many levels, most recently serving as an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri State for the past two seasons. Prior to SMO, Arnold spent four seasons at the helm of the Central Methodist Eagles program where he guided them to a record of 79-45 in his tenure. During the 2012-13 season, he led the Eagles to a 25-8 record and earned a bid to the NAIA Division I National Tournament. He also spent four years as the Head Women's Basketball Coach at Highland Community College in Highland, Kansas, and five years at the helm of the North Central Missouri College in Trenton, Missouri, earning two NJCAA Region 16 Championships, one NJCAA District F Championship.

### Cleaning the Glass

The Lady Miners have done a solid job on the glass this season averaging 38.3 rebounds per game which ranks seventh in the GLVC while their rebounding margin of +3.3 is sixth in the conference. Kim Runge leads the way averaging 8.2 rebounds per game and ranks third in the conference in rebounding. Ashley Harvey is averaging 4.3 per contest and Janie Arand is grabbing 3.6 rebounds per contest.

### Coaching Stability

Alan Eads is the third-longest tenured head coach in the GLVC. Eads, who is in his 16th season at Missouri S&T in 2017-18, trails William Jewell's Jill Cress (22nd season) and Southern Indiana's Rick Stein (18th season). In terms of time spent at GLVC schools he's the second longest tenured behind Stein.

### Three Ball Streak

Since the beginning of the 2003-04 campaign the Lady Miners have made at least one three in 386 of their last 391 games. S&T is currently the top three-point shooting team in the GLVC and there 5.6 made three's per game ranks 10th in the conference.

The Lady Miners are off to a good start this season shooting the three ball connecting on 37.3 percent tops in the GLVC. They made a season-high 11 three's in the win against Missouri Valley on Nov. 18.

Maddie Raley leads the team with 18 three's made while Arand has knocked down 15, Jordan Kabetske has made seven and Marta Durk has knocked down six.

### Quest for 1,000

Janie Arand is looking to become just the 14th player in school history to top the 1,000 point mark for their career. She has currently scored 845 points and needs to average 9.1 points per game to reach that mark. Arand would be the first player to join the 1,000 point club since Hailee Parks accomplished that feat back in the 2012-13 season at Rollins.

### Defending the Home Court

Over the past 12-plus seasons the Lady Miners have defended their home court very well going 111-75 (.597) during that span. Their best season at the Bullman came during the 2007-08 campaign when they went 11-1. They've had five seasons where they've won 10 or more games. The Lady Miners had their first winning season at home since 2012-13 last season when they went 7-6. S&T has won six of its last eight games at home dating back to last season.

### Up Next

The Lady Miners resume GLVC play this coming Thursday traveling up to Kirksville to take on Truman State in a 5:30 p.m. tip-off. S&T is back at home next Saturday hosting Wisconsin-Parkside at 1 p.m. and then will host the Bulldogs the following Thursday in a 5:30 p.m. contest. The Lady Miners then travel to Springfield on the 13th to take on Drury in a 1 p.m. match-up.

**#3 Marta Durk:** A newcomer to the Lady Miner program...she scored 1,252 points, grabbed 321 rebounds and dished out 176 assists during her final three years at O'Fallon Township...she finished her prep career averaging 14.9 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game...she's averaging 4.2 points and 2.7 rebounds per game...made a pair of three's against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11.

**#5 Karleigh Faust:** First season with the Lady Miner program...played in 26 games last season averaging 4.2 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game for Grandview High School in Hillsboro, Mo...helped lead the team to a 22-4 record...has appeared in two contests this season.

**#11 Bria Pierce:** Returned to action against Missouri Southern on Dec. 19 scoring four points and grabbing two rebounds in 16 minutes of play...missed all of last season due to a lower body injury...averaged 11.8 points and 5.1 rebounds per game two years ago.

**#14 Jordan Kabetske:** Second year with the Lady Miner program...scored a career-high 19 points in the loss at Maryville on Dec. 7...she made a career-high three three-pointers in that contest and is shooting 43.8 percent from long range...currently averaging 8.6 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.

**#22 Kim Runge:** In her fourth year with the Lady Miners averaging 3.4 points and 3.9 rebounds in her career...she grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds, 10 on the defensive end, and added six points in the win over Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11...ranks third in the GLVC in rebounding with 8.2 per game.

**#23 Katie Moreno-Bonnett:** Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program after playing the last two seasons at Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City...started 24 games as a sophomore averaging 7.1 points and 5.5 rebounds per game...reached double figures in scoring seven times and had a career-high with 15 against Wentworth Military Academy...she scored a career-high eight points in the loss at Maryville on Dec. 7.

**#24 Janie Arand:** Has scored 20 or more points five times in her career with four of those coming the past two seasons. She scored a career-high 31 points on 11-of-18 shooting in the season-opening win

against LeMoyne-Owen...led the team in scoring last year averaging 10.8 points per game...she needs 155 points to join the 1,000 point club at Missouri S&T...currently ranked 10th in the GLVC in three-point field goal percentage and is 13th in scoring.

**#30 Joe'l Bland:** Matched her season-high with 10 points at Lincoln (Nov. 14) and has scored in double figures 15 times in her career...scored a career-high 22 points against William Jewell in her freshman season on Feb. 21, 2015...for her career she's averaging 5.8 points, 2.7 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 1.1 assists per game and has connected on 46.6 percent of her field goal attempts.

**#32 Ashley Harvey:** In her first season with the Lady Miner program...recorded season-highs in points with nine and rebounds with seven in the win at Lincoln on Nov. 14...began her collegiate career at Penn Valley averaging 10 points and eight rebounds before suffering a season ending injury...was an all-conference performer at Raytown High School in Raytown, Mo...currently averaging 4.8 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.

**#33 Kristin Steins:** Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program...was a three-sport athlete at Parkway South where she averaged 13.5 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.5 steals per game...she was a three-time all-conference and all-district selection and was the Player of the Year in the Suburban West Conference last year...she's also a member of the Lady Miner soccer team...scored her first two points of the season against Union on Nov. 24...followed that up with two points against Arkansas-Fort Smith on Nov. 25...added another two points at Maryville on Dec. 7.

**#34 Maddie Raley:** Second season with the Lady Miner program...she appeared in all 26 games last season averaging 6.1 points and 1.7 rebounds per game...she matched her career-high scoring 20 points against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11... she made a career-high six three's at Bellarmine last season...she currently leads the team with 18 three-pointers made...Raley ranks tied for eighth in the GLVC in three-point field goals made per game with 2.0, 10th in field goal percentage, 11th in scoring and 13th in 3-point field goal percentage.
