The Game:

The Missouri S&T Lady Miners resume Great Lakes Valley Conference play with a trip to Kirkville, Mo. to take on the red hot Truman State Bulldogs on Thursday evening.

The Lady Miners are averaging 70.0 points per game which is seventh in the GLVC. They reached the 80-point mark for the first time since the second game of the season in their win over Westminster on Dec. 30. S&T is struggling on the defensive end though giving up nearly 73 points per game.

Thursday's game will be the 57th meeting all-time between the Lady Miners and Bulldogs with Truman holding a 32-24 advantage in the series. The 'Dogs have won four straight in the series since joining the GLVC in the 2013-14 season. Last year, the Bulldogs blitzed S&T with a three-point shooting barrage making 13 three's in an 89-56 win in Kirkville.

Looking Back:

S&T overcame a slow start by shooting 62 percent from the field in the second of its 80-54 win over the Blue Jays last Saturday. The Lady Miners led by six points at halftime and then pulled away in the final 20 minutes outscoring the Jays 49-27.

Janie Arand led four players in double figures with 17 points. Jordan Kabetske dropped in 14, Ashley Harvey had 11 points and 12 rebounds for her first career double-double and Bria Pierce dropped in 10 points.

Scouting the Competition:

Truman State has run off five wins in a row since suffering a last second defeat at Washburn on Nov. 25. The Bulldogs opened GLVC play defeating Missouri-St. Louis 71-66 and McKendree 76-62. Thursday's game will be the first for the 'Dogs since defeating Missouri Western 77-68 in St. Joseph on Dec. 19.

Truman is fifth in the conference in scoring at 71.9 points per contest but has been really stingy on the defensive end holding its opponents to just 58.2 points per game. Twice this season it has held opponents to under 32 points in a contest.

Katie Jaseckas leads a balanced scoring attack with 12.2 points per night while Ashley Hartwig is dropping in 11.6 points per game.

Painting it Green:

A big key to the Lady Miners success to begin the season this year has been their ability to score in the paint as they've scored at 40 least points five times this season. S&T has outscored its opponents in the paint 363-303 and is averaging 36.3 points per game in the painted area.

The Coaches



Alan Eads, the school's all-time winningest coach, has guided the Lady Miners to a 198-221 record in his 16th season at the helm. He became the school's winningest coach on Jan 29, 2011 with a 65-63 overtime win against Maryville at home.

Last season he guided S&T to a 10-16 mark, 5-13 in the GLVC. He's guided the Lady Miners to the GLVC Tournament nine times including the first nine seasons as a member of the conference.

In his time at S&T he's guided the Lady Miners to NCAA appearances in 2008 and 2011 and were co-champs of the GLVC's West Division in 2010-11.

Amy Eagan, one of the most decorated players in the history of Truman State University women's basketball, is in her fifth season in charge of the Bulldogs. Last year she led Truman to a 15-13 mark, 10-8 which was tied for third in the GLVC's West Division and advanced to their fourth straight GLVC Tournament. In the 2013-14 season she led the Bulldogs to the GLVC Tournament Championship and back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1999. She is 80-45 as the Bulldog head coach and has an overall record of 156-125 in her 10th year as a collegiate head coach. She is third on the Truman career coaching wins list and first in winning percentage by a Truman coach. She is the 10th head coach in the history of Truman Women's Basketball.

Cleaning the Glass

The Lady Miners have done a solid job on the glass this season averaging 38.3 rebounds per game which ranks seventh in the GLVC while their rebounding margin of +3.3 is sixth in the conference. Kim Runge leads the way averaging 8.2 rebounds per game and ranks third in the conference in rebounding. Ashley Harvey is averaging 4.3 per contest and Janie Arand is grabbing 3.6 rebounds per contest.

Coaching Stability

Alan Eads is the third-longest tenured head coach in the GLVC. Eads, who is in his 16th season at Missouri S&T in 2017-18, trails William Jewell's Jill Cress (22nd season) and Southern Indiana's Rick Stein (18th season). In terms of time spent at GLVC schools he's the second longest tenured behind Stein.

Three Ball Streak

Since the beginning of the 2003-04 campaign the Lady Miners have made at least one three in 387 of their last 392 games. S&T is currently the top three-point shooting team in the GLVC and there 5.9 made three's per game ranks 10th in the conference.

The Lady Miners are off to a good start this season shooting the three ball connecting on 38.6 percent tops in the GLVC. They made a season-high 11 three's in the win against Missouri Valley on Nov. 18.

Maddie Raley leads the team with 19 three's made while Arand has knocked down 18, Jordan Kabetske has made 11 and Marta Durk has knocked down seven.

Quest for 1,000

Janie Arand is looking to become just the 14th player in school history to top the 1,000 point mark for their career. She has currently scored 862 points and needs to average 8.6 points per game to reach that mark. Arand would be the first player to join the 1,000 point club since Hailee Parks accomplished that feat back in the 2012-13 season at Rollins.

Defending the Home Court

Over the past 12-plus seasons the Lady Miners have defended their home court very well going 112-75 (.599) during that span. Their best season at the Bullman came during the 2007-08 campaign when they went 11-1. They've had five seasons where they've won 10 or more games. The Lady Miners had their first winning season at home since 2012-13 last season when they went 7-6. S&T has won seven of its last nine games at home dating back to last season.

Up Next

S&T is back at home next Saturday hosting Wisconsin-Parkside at 1 p.m. and then will host the Bulldogs the following Thursday in a 5:30 p.m. contest. The Lady Miners then travel to Springfield on the 13th to take on Drury in a 1 p.m. match-up. S&T returns home on January 15 to take on William Jewell at 5:30 p.m. before beginning a three-game road trip.

#3 Marta Durk: A newcomer to the Lady Miner program...she scored 1,252 points, grabbed 321 rebounds and dished out 176 assists during her final three years at O'Fallon Township...she finished her prep career averaging 14.9 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game...she's averaging 4.7 points and 2.5 rebounds per game...scored a career-high nine points against Westminster on Dec. 30.

#5 Karleigh Faust: First season with the Lady Miner program...played in 26 games last season averaging 4.2 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game for Grandview High School in Hillsboro, Mo...helped lead the team to a 22-4 record...has appeared in three contests this season.

#11 Bria Pierce: Returned to action against Missouri Southern on Dec. 19 scoring four points and grabbing two rebounds in 16 minutes of play...recorded season-highs in points (10) and rebounds (9) against Westminster on Dec. 30...missed all of last season due to a lower body injury...averaged 11.8 points and 5.1 rebounds per game two years ago.

#14 Jordan Kabetske: Second year with the Lady Miner program...scored a career-high 19 points in the loss at Maryville on Dec. 7...she made a career-high four three-pointers against Westminster on Dec. 30 and is shooting 50.0 percent from long range...currently averaging 9.1 points, 3.2 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game...tied for second in the conference in three-point field goal percentage.

#22 Kim Runge: In her fourth year with the Lady Miners averaging 3.4 points and 3.9 rebounds in her career...she grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds, 10 on the defensive end, and added six points in the win over Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11...ranks third in the GLVC in rebounding with 8.2 per game.

#23 Katie Moreno-Bonnett: Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program after playing the last two seasons at Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City...started 24 games as a sophomore averaging 7.1 points and 5.5 rebounds per game...reached double figures in scoring seven times and had a career-high with 15 against Wentworth Military Academy...she scored a career-high eight points in the loss at Maryville on Dec. 7.

#24 Janie Arand: Has scored 20 or more points five times in her career with four of those coming the past two seasons. She scored a career-high 31 points on 11-of-18 shooting in the season-opening win against LeMoyné-Owen...she needs 138 points to join the 1,000 point club at Missouri S&T...currently ranked ninth in the GLVC in three-point field goal percentage and is 10th in scoring.

#30 Joe'l Bland: Matched her season-high with 10 points at Lincoln (Nov. 14) and has scored in double figures 15 times in her career...scored a career-high 22 points against William Jewell in her freshman season on Feb. 21, 2015...for her career she's averaging 5.8 points, 2.7 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 1.1 assists per game and has connected on 46.6 percent of her field goal attempts.

#32 Ashley Harvey: In her first season with the Lady Miner program...recorded season-highs in points with 11 and rebounds with 12 in the win against Westminster on Dec. 30...began her collegiate career at Penn Valley averaging 10 points and eight rebounds before suffering a season ending injury...was an all-conference performer at Raytown High School in Raytown, Mo...currently averaging 5.4 points and 5.1 rebounds per game.

#33 Kristin Steins: Another newcomer to the Lady Miner program...was a three-sport athlete at Parkway South where she averaged 13.5 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.5 steals per game...she was a three-time all-conference and all-district selection and was the Player of the Year in the Suburban West Conference last year...she's also a member of the Lady Miner soccer team...scored a career-high four points against Westminster on Dec. 30.

#34 Maddie Raley: Second season with the Lady Miner program...she appeared in all 26 games last season averaging 6.1 points and 1.7 rebounds per game...she matched her career-high scoring 20 points against Purdue Northwest on Nov. 11... she made a career-high six three's at Bellarmine last season...she currently leads the team with 19 three-pointers made...Raley ranks tied for 10th in three-point field goals made with 1.9 and is 13th in scoring.
